Course structure

The course focuses on the vocabulary and grammar essential to the role of a flight attendant and includes:

- Pre-flight briefing
- Welcome on-board
- Take-off
- Cabin services
- Medical emergencies

- Safety and other emergencies
- Disruptive passengers
- Preparing for landing
- Saying good bye
- Applying for a job and interviews

The course is tailor-made for individuals according to your level of English and your specific requirements, ensuring that you make maximum progress in the time available. Our materials are designed to challenge and stimulate learning by encouraging discussion through question and answer sessions, role plays and describing photographs.

Lessons

A typical lesson is based around either a phase of flight or a particular situation a flight attendant may have to deal with, for example Preparing for Take-off or Disruptive Passengers. The lessons are highly interactive and

involve a communicative approach, producing a dynamic learning environment. The lessons are very much focused on the learner and encourage discussion through question and answer sessions, role plays and description of photographs. For example, discussion might develop around dealing with disruptive passengers, handling the situation in a professional manner and any first hand experiences of the flight attendant. During the lesson the teacher offers correction and advice which helps the learner to improve accuracy and fluency.



1:1 Aviation English in the UK



Our UK courses are based in Oxford an important cultural centre with a wealth of history and traditional architecture. You can choose to stay with one of our host families or we can assist you in choosing a hotel or B&B. We try to find accommodation within walking distance of your classes, but if this is not possible, you may need to use public transport. The course runs for a minimum of one week and includes 25 hours of 1:1 tuition per week. Your lessons take place at our school in Oxford from Monday to Friday and the following lesson times are usually adopted:

During the lessons you will practise speaking, pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary and listening, and you will also be given about 2 to 3 hours of homework to complete every evening.
